Red Cross Standard First Aid: 16 Hours



- Prerequisites:** Minimum 18 years of age.
- Course Materials:** Required materials provided.
- Required P.P.E.:** Not applicable
- Course Overview:** This sixteen (16) hour Red Cross Standard First Aid program consists of classroom, and practical exercises, with an emphasis on current emergency management standards and practical components. The student shall learn proper emergency care according to the Canadian Red Cross. This program provides the student with the foundation skills to confidently and efficiently use the first aid skills taught in an emergency situation. Special attention shall be given to personal safety precautions and techniques. Upon successful completion the student shall be issued a Canadian Red Cross certificate and wallet card valid for three (3) years. ****Re-certification timeframes may be less than three (3) years if required by the employer. Yearly re-certification for cardio pulmonary resuscitation is recommended.***
